(Where Consortium / Joint Venture / Sub-contractors are involved, each party to the association must submit a separate Valid Tax Clearance Certificate or a unique security personal Identification number). ❖ Municipal services (water, sanitation, rates and electricity) clearance certificate or Lease Agreement with a Current Bill of Account not owing more than one hundred and twenty (120) days; ❖ Valid proof of registration on the National Treasury's Central Suppliers' database must be accompany this bid; ❖ All responses must adhere to the following pre-qualification criteria for preferential procurement – A tenderer having a stipulated minimum B-BBEE status level two (2) of contributor for which the following documents will be required to verify. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ Tenderers who qualify as Exempted Micro Enterprises (EMEs), can submit a sworn affidavit signed by the EME representative and attested by a Commissioner of oaths. ➢ Tenderers other than EMEs are required to submit proof of B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificates issued by SANAS accredited agencies, (Proof includes original and valid B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificates or certified copies thereof together with their tenders or price quotations, to substantiate their B-BBEE rating claims). ➢ A trust, consortium or joint venture (including unincorporated consortia and joint ventures) must submit a consolidated B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificate for every separate tender. ➢ Tertiary institutions and other state entities interest must also submit B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificates together with their tenders. ❖ Training providers currently accredited to offer National Certificate: Building and Civil Construction – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ Secondary accreditation – service providers who are accredited to provide other fields Construction and Environment training. - ❖ Completed Attendance of the compulsory clarification meetings, details of which are stated in the advert and the tender document.

The points scored for price will be added to the points scored for B-BBEE status level of contribution (Maximum of 20 points) to obtain the bidder's total points scored out of 100 in accordance with the PPPFA and the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017.
