A valid CSD master registration number must be provided to that effect. ❖ Potential Bidders must have a contractor registered at CIDB Grading Level of 8CE or higher as part of their team. 7CE PE contractors who meet the criteria stated in the tender document may submitted tenders. (Valid Proof must be attached). ❖ Pre-qualification criteria in line with the PPR of 2017: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ A minimum of B-BBEE level one (1) of contribution certificate or higher, i.e. B-BBEE Certificate Level 2 contribution and below will not be considered. (Where trust, consortium or joint venture (including unincorporated consortia and joint ventures) must submit a consolidated B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificate for every separate tender. An original or certified copy of the original must be attached. ○ Only tenderers subcontracting a minimum of 30% of the contract value (scope of works) to the following enterprises. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Minimum 25% must be sub – contracted to EMEs or QSEs which are at least 51% owned by black people. The bid will first be evaluated on functionality [Detailed functionality criteria will be outlined in the bid document]. Bidders who fail to obtain a minimum of 75 points out of 100 points for functionality will not be considered for further evaluation on price and preference.

The bid will be evaluated on Method 2 Functionality, Financial Offer and Preference:

The points scored for price will be added to the points scored for B-BBEE status level of contribution (Maximum of 10 points) to obtain the bidder's total points scored out of 100 in accordance with the PPPFA and the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017.

A compulsory clarification meeting, will take place at **Charles Mopeli Stadium, Phuthaditjhaba on Monday, 20 January 2020 starting at 10h00. Failure to attend this clarification meeting will lead to disqualification.**
